

ACCOUNTABLE MANAGER WEBINAR

Webinar Overview

The revised Part 139 Manual of Standards (August 2020) states an Accountable Manager must be formally nominated for each certified aerodrome. The Accountable Manager is required to have a certain level of knowledge, understanding, and demonstrated ability to comply with the aviation standards and regulations as they apply to the safety of the aerodrome.

The team at AMS have researched the requirements of this role and developed this webinar to assist new and emerging Accountable Managers gain an awareness of their many responsibilities under sub regulation 139.110 (5) of the Civil Aviation Safety Regulations (CASR).

The Accountable Manager is best characterised by their authorities and responsibilities which may include (but is not limited to):

- full authority for human resources issues,
- authority for major financial decisions,
- direct responsibility of the affairs of the organisation,
- final authority over airside operations under the aerodrome certificate, and
- final responsibility over all safety issues.

We will explore the responsibilities of the Accountable Manager, including training and knowledge requirements for the Accountable Manager and their team, key legislation that relates to this position, and discuss the role in a relaxed workshop environment.
